

Things You Need to Know:



Wristbands are your ticket to the event and **must** be worn around your wrist at all times. If a wristband gets damaged, please take it to Registration for a replacement.

Security: Security personnel will be on duty throughout the event, as well as periodic visits by the State Police. Impact security will be identified by fluorescent vests.

Showers: Showers at the RV Park are for campers in those respective areas. The cabin area showers are open to those staying in Tent City. Shower units are available on the camping field for those staying in Tent City.

Water: Drinking water is available at multiple sites: Tent City Shower area and below Lower Barn

ICE: Bags of ice can be purchased at the SnL Café in the Lower Barn. Ice can also be reserved for camp site delivery any morning of Impact. Simply sign-up, list your camp site number and pre-pay for your ice and it will be delivered before 8:00 a.m.

Vehicle Parking: <u>One</u> vehicle per group is allowed to park on the field or in front of cabins. This does not include any vehicle that is being used for sleeping. All other vehicles need to park in the large overflow parking area in the back of tent city.

Shuttling to the Arena Area: All persons will need to walk to the arena area via the marked trail behind the infirmary or from Tent City and the RV Park. Handicap parking is available in front of the barn, please visit registration to obtain a parking pass.

Children's Ministry: Children's ministry will be available from 10:45 - 12 noon in the upper barn and from 2:00 - 3:30. The children will enjoy puppets, crafts, bible stories, etc. with ministry provided by the Kingdom Kids Puppet Team.

Swimming: Swimming will be available each day for children 11 and under from 3:30 - 5:00. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Medical Issues: There will be a nurse on duty at all times. For medical assistance (other than during arena times), please report to HQ (manor building.) During program times, medical personnel will be available at the arena. Please make sure your group is drinking lots of water to prevent dehydration and heat exhaustion. Make sure to use sunscreen, even on overcast days. If a youth member of your group requires attention at the infirmary, an adult must accompany him/her

SnL Café: A well-supplied snack shop is open throughout the event in the lower part of the barn. Fruit salads, a variety of sandwiches, soft pretzels, nachos and cheese, soda, water and more are available. All proceeds support Salt 'n Light. In addition, Greene Hills is offering snow cones and popcorn in the snack area. All proceeds from these products benefit Camp Greene Hills. The lower barn will be closed each day from 1:30 - 4:30 and during the evening speaker.

Apparel: Impact, Salt'n Light and guest artists merchandise will be available in the lower barn throughout the event.

Sound Curfew: Out of respect for surrounding groups, we ask that you keep noise to a minimum. Generator use is prohibited 12:00am- 7:00am.

Fire Wood: Available at Tent City on a donation basis. You may bring your own firewood for campfires.

Lost and Found: Retrieved items will be collected and can be picked up at the side stage area.

Stewardship: Please help us keep the entire grounds clean. A large dumpster is located at tent city for your garbage. Also, please police your main stage sitting area at the end of the day.

Nightly Offering: Each evening an offering will be received to support a variety of ministries. Announcements will be made each day related to the evening offering.

Important Special Note: A well marked area has been cut from the road to the creek at the lower end of the Greene Hills property. You may also walk the road all the way to the State Game lands and enter the creek. <u>DO NOT ENTER THE CREEK CROSSING THE</u> <u>NEIGHBOR'S PRIVATE PROPERTY</u>. Thank you!
