SnL Headquarters (HQ) Tent and Commuter Area

SnL will have a tent set up in Tent City to serve as a headquarters within the camp.

The HQ tent will have community tables and chairs, a simple first aid kit, a walkie talkie that can be used to contact our staff, a handwashing station, and our **shower board**.

We will also have some board games, coloring books, and other simple craft supplies available. This space can be used as a communal hangout spot whenever desired! Feel free to invite your groups to eat together, hang out, play games, or use the space for some inter-youth group interaction throughout the week. There will also be a **Commuter Area** in Tent City for groups commuting to the event, or groups visiting for one day. They can eat their meals here and hangout in their free time. Please bring some camping chairs and all your snacks, water, supplies for free time, and meals, etc!

Showers

We are excited to have warm showers available for Revive this year! We will have a two-stall commercial shower trailer onsite for the whole event.

To make sure everyone has a fair chance to shower each day without waiting in a long line, we will use a simple time-slot system.

At the SnL HQ tent, there will be a shower board with clothespins on it. Each clothespin will have a 10-minute shower time slot. *Think 5–6 minutes to shower and the rest of the time to change.* Each person will take one clothespin, participate in the day as usual, and then head up to the showers a minute or two before their time slot. When they arrive, they will hand their clothespin to the shower attendant and enjoy their shower — no line, no wait! The shower board will open at **6:50am** each morning.



A few important notes:

- ☐ One clothespin per person.
- ☐ You must be present to take your own clothespin. One person **cannot** take multiple clothespins to distribute to people who are not there.
- ☐ **Please do not miss your time slot!** We will do our best to accommodate people, but the system only works if everyone honors it. Please help us by encouraging your students and leaders to respect the system.
- ☐ Shower times will be limited to certain parts of the day:
- ☐ 7:00–9:10am-Last morning slot begins at 9:00am.
- ☐ 1:30–5:30pm- Last afternoon slot begins at 5:10pm.
- ☐ *These slots will be extended if we have an influx of overnight guests.*
- ☐ Showers will be closed in the evening unless there is an emergency need. If an evening shower is absolutely needed, you can contact SnL Staff by text or through the walkie at HQ.
- ☐ On Friday after the Creek Float, there will be an extended shower hour reserved just for creek participants. These will be 8-minute showers from 5:00–6:00pm. Normal showers will run from 1:30–5pm that afternoon.

We *thank you in advance* for your grace with us! We know that having warm showers on site elevates the event experience for our guests. We will make adjustments if necessary. We encourage attendees to strongly consider not showering everyday, due to accommodating so many campers. We are thrilled to roll out this new feature and understand it will be something we continue to learn from! Your grace and patience with us is appreciated.

Important Note About the Shower Trailer Toilets

The shower stalls also have a sink and toilet, but we will not be using the toilets. **The water for the toilets will be turned off.** There will be signs posted, and the toilet lids will be taped shut.

Please make sure your students and leaders know that the **shower trailer is for showers only**. There will be porta-potties onsite, and, during indoor sessions and events, indoor bathrooms will be available.

Please, please do not use the toilets in the shower trailers!

Handwashing Station

We will also have a dual-sink handwashing station at the HQ tent. This can be used for washing hands and brushing teeth.

The station will have a hose hookup, so fresh water will flow when the pedal pumps are pushed. The wastewater will drain through a hose into a closed bucket underneath.

This is where we need your help, youth leaders! If you notice that one of the wastewater buckets is full, please swap it out with one of the empty buckets and set the full bucket aside. This will be especially helpful during the morning and evening rush when students are brushing their teeth.



Our team will come through in the mornings and evenings to empty full buckets and reset everything.

If all of the buckets are full, please text our team or use the walkie at HQ to contact a team member.

Rinse-Off Station

If students or leaders just need to rinse mud off their feet, clean something off, or do not need a full shower, they can use the rinse-off station. This will be a hose hookup over by the pavilion.

Extra Activities at Revive

Each day, there will be a special afternoon activity! All activities are optional, and the schedule may change based on weather.

Wednesday: Inflatable Water Slide and Water Games

Students should bring swimsuits or clothes they do not mind getting wet if they want to participate. They may also want flip-flops or water shoes to wear to and from the slide and games.

Per SnL policies, we ask that girls wear a one-piece swimsuit or a dark shirt/tank over a two-piece swimsuit. We ask that guys wear a dark shirt with their swim trunks. *All torsos covered.*

Thursday: Bingo

Come try your luck with some friendly competition! There will be fun prizes for the winners.

Friday: Breeches Float and Cozy Indoor Movie

On Friday, students will have two optional afternoon activity choices: the Breeches Float or a cozy indoor movie.

For the Breeches Float, some SnL team members will bring the SnL van to Messiah and float along with you and your students down the Breeches. Please bring your own tubes!

SnL team will help organize transportation from the ending point back to your vehicles. Please make sure you send at least one leader for every 8 students, and that any students who participate are able to swim. SnL team members will be there to join the fun, but they are not responsible for supervising your students.

For the cozy indoor movie, students can bring blankets, pillows, stuffed animals, or anything else they might want to be cozy and chill inside while watching a family-friendly movie together.

Security, Nurse/EMTs

We will monitor entrances and exits and be vigilant about security measures. Please call or text us with any concerns. Additionally, we will have a nurse or EMT present throughout the event. Contact us if you or a student needs their assistance.



Cooking, Food, Meal Preparations

Salt 'n Light will **not** be selling any food, ice, drinks, or snacks at this event. All meals are the responsibility of groups commuting or camping. This means that you are welcome to bring any needed supplies for meals: generators, grills, skillets, water buckets, coolers, etc. You are welcome to visit any local restaurants during meal times, too! Please be fully prepared for feeding your groups.

Yes, you can have campfires! But, please bring a fire ring to elevate, solo stove, or a safe way to lift campfires off of the grass. Fires are permitted per the township's fire regulations that week! **Note:** we do not have campfire wood or rings for sale.

Noise Ordinance and Rules to Follow

There is a 10pm noise ordinance for the neighborhood where we are hosting Revive. Please do not use generators after 10pm and keep noise to a minimum at campsites. There are residential areas near our event. Do NOT go close to private property.
